- B. UCSF Decarbonization Study Audrey Waller and Gail Lee
 - a. UC has set an ambitious policy goal to reduce total emissions (scope 1, 2, and 3) at least **90% by 2045** without relying on carbon offsets at all UC Campuses
 - b. UCSF's Decarbonization Study
 - i. Review of existing low carbon heating technologies; various heat pumps, geothermal wells, and sewer heat recovery
 - ii. Develop a roadmap to shift buildings off steam, reduce heating demands, and install new heating systems
 - iii. Plan to increase reliability of electrical services in preparation for increased reliance on the grid
 - 1. UCSF's majority of carbon emissions are largely from heating
