- A. UCSF Classroom Renovations – Matt Epperson
- a. Looking for feedback on classrooms – technology, lighting, furniture
 - b. Seats in HSW are very uncomfortable, chairs not wide enough, more standing room/desks
 - c. Cole Hall has no available outlets
 - d. Desks are very small
 - e. What about the S rooms?
 - i. We like the desks and you can take out the cabinets
 - f. What about cubby space?
 - i. We don't need it but lockers are still needed in mission bay
 - g. One of the study rooms in the library has a very annoying clicking sound that is disturbing
 - i. Library has been discussing renovations and reorganizing public vs. UCSF space. Students think it would be great to let them know what we would like.
 - h. HSW are very loud and there are some smells going into the rooms
 - i. One thing we get a lot of requests for are microwaves – nursing mezzanine, HSW lobby, or any common area, lobby near N217/225
 - j. Chairs in the library like Hearst – start sinking into them
 - k. Mission Bay is great
 - l. Any chance of getting more colored printers?
 - i. We could look into it
 - m. For a quarter, we did have our lectures closed captioned. Is that able to happen again?
 - i. I would have to look into it. There is another company that we are looking into that is much cheaper to capturing everything. If people
