C. NEW BUSINESS / ACTION (5:40-6:25)

- A. RCO Funding Update – Kathy Chew
Kathy presenting on RCO funding. ~\$91,000 budget and \$91,000 already allocated this year to 214 RCOs. Lots of interprofessional events have been funded this year. Disproportionate amount of funding in each school though. Funding is used for outreach, cultural, community service, meetings, etc... We need to review budget and rules for funding. GPSA needs to decide what amount and guidelines we want to change for more sustainable budget for the remaining 4 months of this year and how to amend the funding guidelines for next year. GPSA decided that we will pull \$20,000 from roll-over reserves to award to RCOs for the remaining 4 months. Will ask all RCOs to submit their funding requests for the rest of the year by **March 28** to see if the \$20,000 will cover all requests. During April GPSA meeting, will discuss how to amend the funding guidelines for 2025-26.
- B. Futbol Club RCO Request – Hannah Takasuka
Requesting money for interprofessional soccer club. \$120 per field reservation per two hours. Usually two-hour reservations weekly or biweekly. Asking for \$1,200 for field reservations until end of year. Group meets off-campus and has already asked for funding from GPSA and other sources. GPSA discussed and approved funding for \$600 for the rest of the year.

Asking for students to read and sign a letter of support. Honglip met with Dean Blake who plans to talk to legislators etc regarding NIH proposed cuts.
