Professional Degree Supplemental Tuition – Jennifer Rosko The budget office will be requesting student input on the proposed PDST increases; however students will not been given much time to review the proposals. We would like a more organized system to collect student input and more than two days to respond. In preparation for these proposals, student leaders will announce to their corresponding schools that this increase is taking place in order to prepare them to give their input. Does GPSA want to write a letter regarding the insufficient amount of time to review proposals? UCSA has raised an opposition to tuition increases due to its limited transparency.

- e. Presidential Policy Review–Jennifer Rosko
 The UC sexual violence policy is open for comments on proposed changes.
 - Student Carpool Permits Jennifer Rosko
 UCSF Transportation proposes to implement student carpool parking permits at
 Parnassus, and they need GPSA to vote on the guidelines. These permits are a
 temporary solution to the housing shortage for students. Due to limited spots,
 should the spots be assigned on a first come, first serve basis or a lottery?
 Proposed criteria for permit eligibility:
 - Beneficiaries of this permit cannot be in student housing.
 - There should be a minimum of 3 passengers for the carpool.
 - The permits should expire and be re-evaluated on a yearly basis.
 - Priority might be given based on student's location.

There was a consensus that there needs to be better education of the student population regarding the nature of the program.
